

# The Grace represented by the word, 'Always'

**Praise with joy :** 'Your Love'

**Scripture Reading :** 2 Kings 13 : 20 - 25

**Opening the Heart :**

If you have ever sent a loved one first to God's kingdom and experienced loss and fear because of that empty space, share about it.

**Observation of the Word :**

1. What happened after Elisha died? (2 Kings 13 : 20)
2. What covenant did God bring toward Israel that caused him to show her grace? (2 Kings 13 : 23)

**Study of the Word :**

1. Even though Elisha died, what's the reason that God showed a miracle where the body that touched Elisha's bones came back to life? (2 Kings 13 : 21, Ezekiel 37 : 1 - 10)  
[Reference : Biblical theology (Geehardus Vos) says this is the event that proves the Word of the Lord still lives and works among Israel beyond the physical limit of death.]
2. What is prosperity (Tsalach) that the Bible speaks about? (2 Kings 13 : 22, Genesis 39 : 2)
3. Why did God take care of Israel not on the covenant with David, but on the older patriarchal covenant (the covenant with Abraham)? (2 Samuel 7 : 16)

**Application & Sharing :**

1. Share if you have experienced comfort and hope from knowing that God is still alive and working beyond physical limits.
2. Share if difficult circumstances or relationships helped you get closer to God and experience the grace represented by the word, 'always'.

**Prayer in Response to the Word :**

1. Help us realize that God never abandons us and the hardships can be a sign to call us back to Him, and hold tightly the relationship with God under any circumstance even in hardships and difficult situations.
2. Help us believe that the true prosperous life is not one without hardship but one that walks with God in every situation, walking with God to the end trusting His covenant and unchanging love.
3. May the sick members of Inland Church rely only on Jesus and experience the Lord's help and healing.
